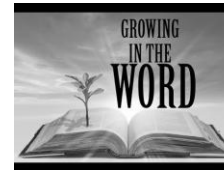

The Council held its monthly meeting this past Tuesday. The reports were given by the officers and discussed. Notes from the reports.

Treasurer's Report.

- It was noted with thanks that the offerings during the Christmas season met our ministerial needs. A letter of thanks was reviewed and approved and will be included with the year-end giving statements.
- Our Quickbooks Accounting system has been updated and implemented as of January 1.
- An audit was discussed. The matter was tabled until closer to the end of the fiscal year.

Trustee's Report.

- Representatives for the NV Energy efficiency program were here. We are waiting to hear back from them on any further lighting grants.

The Elder's Report.

- A letter of encouragement for the delinquents was discussed and approved. A Stewardship program for the fall was also discussed.

Pastor's Report.

- Pastor noted, with thanks, all the prayers, well-wishes and help that the family has received during Kelley's hospitalization and recuperation.
- The Sunday Service, on Feb 2, will be moved to 10:00 am to assist the CLHS choir.

New Business:

- The Open Forum Agenda for January 26 was discussed and approved by the Council.
- The water bill was discussed. Although we have not been able to find a solution in the past, Erik Braun and Duane Meyer are willing to pursue a possible solution.
- Activities Committee ideas and plans were discussed. They are working with some new ideas and plans.
