News and Notes from the Council

The Council met on Tuesday evening. The Treasurer gave the financial report. The numbers for the month of March were presented and discussed. We thanked the Lord that special offerings were given for several crucial evangelism projects.

The Treasurer also noted that the E-Giving program has been set up with the company. We are awaiting the instructions and the software to set up on the church's system. When that is completed we will be ready to set up that giving.

The Trustees reported that they are still speaking with an AC company in order to replace our 20 year old AC control panels which are beginning to fail.

The Elders noted that church attendance went down between Christmas and Easter. In January, attendance averaged 76. In March, average attendance was 63. They also noted

that the invitations before Easter went very well. Over 400 homes were knocked on by 15 people over the two weekends of inviting. We plan on continuing this type of invitation with our New Mover Mailer Program.

The Elders will be sending a letter of encouragement to some of the families that have not been with us in worship and communion for several months. We pray that God works through this letter to bring his people to their place in the Lord's house and at this table.

Notes will also be sent to those who have not had their picture taken for the picture board. We would like to have that finished by the beginning of the summer.

The Council had several items of new business for discussion. Some items had been previously discussed at Ladies Guild and Ministry Team. Discussion topics included: 1. Lowered attendance at Lenten Meals and possible solutions/changes. 2. Summer Fellowship time and snacks. 3. Luther Movie Night. and 4. Requests for Use of the Building.

Finally, June's Open Forum and Voter's Meeting was discussed. We have many positions, elected and volunteer, that need to be filled. A letter was handed out this morning to all the eligible voting members of the congregation requesting their service. We expect to be able to elect a full slate of officers in June.
