Chapter 8: A Humanitarian by Becoming Man

9. How did God become man?

✦ Matthew 1:20. But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, “Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

✦ Luke 2:7. and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

10. If Jesus Christ is not God and man in one person, he cannot possibly be our Savior. Explain.

A. Jesus had to be True Man so that:

✦ Galatians 4:4-5. But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, ⁵ to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons.

✦ Mark 10:45. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

✦ Hebrews 4:15. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.

Jesus’ Active Obedience:

B: Jesus had to be True God so that:

- ✦ Romans 5:19. For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.
- ✦ Psalm 49:7-8. No man can redeem the life of another or give to God a ransom for him—⁸the ransom for a life is costly, no payment is ever enough

Jesus' Passive Obedience:

11. Why do you think so many religions have such a difficult time believing that Jesus Christ is not only a man, but also God?

- ✦ 1 Timothy 3:16. Beyond all question, the mystery of godliness is great: He appeared in a body, was vindicated by the Spirit, was seen by angels, was preached among the nations, was believed on in the world, was taken up in glory.

12. Read Philippians 2:5-8 and discuss how Jesus' humbling himself and becoming man shows God to be the Ultimate Humanitarian.

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:

⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, ⁷ but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death— even death on a cross!
